



COMMISSIONER RESPONSIBILITIES

Within each community one mutually agreed-upon person is appointed Commissioner. A Junior Giants Commissioner is responsible for the complete organization of the league in his or her area. Organizing a league includes, but is not limited to, the following:

- Being the lead contact person with the Giants Community Fund
- Recruiting kids and coaches (e.g., developing league awareness and promoting the program throughout schools and community centers)
- Addressing all staffing issues (e.g., recruiting coaches, volunteers, etc.)
- Attend Commissioners Meeting at AT&T Park
- Communicate regularly with Community Fund staff on the league's activities
- Coordinating coaches to attend one coaching clinic a year
- Holding a mandatory coaches meeting before the season begins to cover league philosophies (e.g., emphasizing the non-competitive nature of Junior Giants)
- Holding a mandatory League Orientation Meeting with all players and parents to cover league philosophy and programs
- Securing baseball fields for practices and games
- Creating practice and game schedules
- Distributing all equipment and uniforms
- Submitting player and coach signed waivers to the Community Fund
- Collecting and taking inventory of all equipment and shirts
- Organizing Junior Giants Day/Night tickets
- Encourage participation in the Education, Health and Violence Prevention programs
