The Team Parent works with the Coach to help coordinate the programs that go beyond baseball. Team Parents focus on instilling the Four Bases of Character Development as well as the programs in Education, Health and Violence Prevention.

DUTIES

- Help teach the Four Bases of Character Development and encourage participation in the Education, Health and Violence Prevention programs.
- Help your team adhere to the Junior Giants schedule throughout the season by focusing on each week's initiative.
- Assist in the Take Me Out to the Ball Game program by labeling each pack of cards for every Junior Giant on your team and passing out cards as they are earned.
- Coordinate the Round the Bases Reading Program; encourage all players to read during the summer months to earn Giants prizes.
- Review the Health Program by reminding players of their Nutrition Lineup Magnet, Health Poster and Grand Slam Groceries Coupon Book received in their Handbooks.
- Challenge players to track their nutrition and physical activity on their Nutrition Lineup Magnet for a week.
- Reward players who successfully tracked their nutrition and physical activity for a week by passing out water bottles.
- Encourage each team member to participate in the Imagine Peace Contest; collect entries and turn them into your league Commissioner.
- Review the Peace Pledge with players and remind them of the oath they took. Encourage them to wear their Strike Out Violence wristbands.
